



"Wanderlust was born during the pandemic, a time when we were unable to travel very far from our front doors, let alone explore new places. Given the magical capacity of music to transport us elsewhere—if even briefly—we wanted to take our listeners on a musical voyage instead."

Lara Deutsch collaborates with the guitarist Adam Cicchillitti on Wanderlust, a programme evoking musical portraits of 20th-century life around the world. This programme conjures images of natural landscapes, historical events, and folklore across the continents. Through the evocative sounds of the flute and guitar, this performance immerses you in a rich tapestry of folkloric music. The voyage encompasses compositions by Canadian artists Jason Noble and John Armstrong, as well as renowned names like Bartok, Chopin, Piazzolla, Toru Takemitsu, and Gabriela Ortiz. The duo resonates with the diverse flavours of these musical traditions, creating a unique and captivating experience.

Kathleen was a Lancastrian who became a household name and her death, from cancer, came as a huge shock to the nation. #### **Blah Theatre** The Hidden Garden





"I want to try harder to plant new things."

"It makes me want to help my neighbours out."

#### A Hidden Garden explores food poverty, community, migration and growing as activism.

In a city full of concrete, there is a garden hidden away behind the rows of terraced housing. surrounded by a high fence. It is bursting with flowers, fruit, and vegetables. The man who lives here grows them to brighten up the grey, and to feed himself. One day, a child accidentally discovers the garden; at first, he is not welcome, but as the seasons change, a friendship blooms. As the man's trust in people grows through his friendship with the child, the walls of the garden come down and the man is encouraged to take his first steps out into his local community.

The show was developed in partnership with Trees for Cities, a national charity dedicated to planting trees in urban areas and uniting communities through the creation of shared green spaces. They also run the Edible Playgrounds initiative creating food growing areas in school playgrounds, educating teachers and pupils on growing foodstuffs and supporting healthy and fresh school meals. The show comes with a post-show activity for children and grown-ups. They will have the chance to learn about growing and planting and will take home seeds that will grow indoors at home.


